

WHAT YOU DIDN'T KNOW ABOUT YOUR BLACKBERRY

Your BlackBerry packs a handful of features and shortcuts designed to save you time. Here are a few new tricks.



1 WEB BROWSER SHORTCUTS

Speed up your surfing significantly with this handy collection of shortcuts for BlackBerry smartphones with SureType QWERTY keyboards.

HOW TO

To bookmark a web page, press the **?** key.

To type in a new URL, open the "Go To..." screen by **pressing 5**.

Zoom in on a web page by **pressing ","** (comma). To zoom out **press "."** (period).

To move down a web page screen, press **9**.

To scroll to the bottom of a web page **press 7**. Go back to the top by **pressing 1**.

2 MOD UR BERRY

Show off your incredible style – and ability to multi-task – with these four new BlackBerry apps.

Pimp my Mail

Customize the colour of your blinking incoming email indicator light to identify up to seven email contacts. It's not a ring tone, it's a blink tone.

BlackBerry Themes

Trick out your BlackBerry with a cool theme, complete with custom icons, backgrounds, menus and fonts.

Mod UR Light

Turn your LED status light into a status symbol. Make it your own with seven colours and five effects, including Disco Ball.

Mod UR Pearl

Turn your Pearl's trackball into a trend transmitter by customizing it with your choice of seven colours and five effects, such as Rainbow or Dimmer.

HOW TO

Launch your BlackBerry's mobile Internet browser.

Select the **Do More** or **Apps** icon from the home screen.

Follow the prompts to download the app of your choice.

3 MASTER YOUR MUSIC

The unassuming BlackBerry is one awesome music phone. Pop in a microSD card, sync it with your PC's music library (including iTunes support) and plug in the bundled earphones. Here's how to take better control over your tunes.

HOW TO

When listening to music, navigate tracks by **pressing and holding the volume keys**:

- Next Track – **Volume Up**
- Previous Track – **Volume Down**

Pause music while it's playing by **pressing the Mute key**, located on the left side of the device, above the headset jack.

You can listen to music while using other applications. If you want to know what song is playing, return to the Media Player to read the **Now Playing** info.

Customize sound in the Media Player by activating the equalizer (**Media Player > Music > Menu > Equalizer**) and choosing from 11 settings, such as Jazz, Lounge and Dance.
